The program includes weekly meetings, facilitated by College Success Coaches, Career Coaching, and other opportunities.

Students selected for the TSIC program commit to:

- Stay drug and crime free
- Maintain at least a 2.5 unweighted cumulative GPA and a 'C' or above in all courses
- Attend school regularly (No more than 4 absences per quarter)
- Exhibit good behavior in and out of school
- Volunteer and become involved in the community
- Meet weekly with their mentor on school grounds (or in a virtual supervised setting, when necessary)
- Complete program curriculum and yearly benchmarks (this is a program serving your child in eighth through twelfth grades)
- Participate in all program activities, meetings, and events
